- Information on this card will be kept strictly confidential by the USW. Administrators will NOT know you signed a card unless you tell them.
- You are NOT giving up your individual right to deal directly with any members of the administration, faculty, or staff.
- NO fees or dues are required to sign this card.

This card will be used to secure Union recognition and collective bargaining rights. By signing it, you are taking an important step toward achieving a genuine voice in workplace decisions that affect you.
